Subject: re: Grid Conditions Update for late next week

Lege Leadership Staff,

Good afternoon. We just wanted to provide a brief update on the approaching cold weather event for mid to late next week across the ERCOT Region. Models seem to be aligned on colder temperatures; however, they are not yet aligned on the timing of the front. At this time, ERCOT is preparing for our most conservative/extreme case forecasts of approx. 72,000 MW demand next Friday morning (02/04/22). A note that our winter season all-time peak was set last year at 69,812MWs. ERCOT is evaluating all avenues to ensure as much capacity as available is online.

As we are still a number of days away from the noted time period, there are a number of variables that can impact the load forecast. We will be continually monitoring conditions and update you as we have additional information.

We will plan for regular updates to begin Monday morning unless conditions warrant otherwise.
