Lyn Thurmond sent photographs c/o swollen feet on two male juveniles. Both were involved in situation on 2/14/2021 in which their feet were in snow/ice related for an unknown time. They now are complaining of pain/discomfort in area of both feet. There is some swelling of both feet, extending into toes and big toe. Hurts to stand on feet. They did not use any hot water or unusual warming that is known to us. Photographs show small amount of swelling, some edema to toe areas. Nurse relates they have good feeling in feet, vital signs stable, color of feet pink.

Impression:

Exposure to cold to both feet on 2/14/2021

Resulting swelling from exposure

Disposition:

Stay off feet. Elevate feet when easy to do.

Can use wheel chair for mobility

Do not soak/do not use hot water (their sensation to pain may be reduced)

Can take shower

May have Tylenol prn

Report to nurses any changes
