a table with food on it. The complainant said that the area around the table was crowded, and people were coming and going. The complainant said she went to the table to see what food was available. The complainant said that she felt someone push up against her. The complainant stated that she moved and saw the suspect rubbing against her. The complainant said she did not think much about the incident and went to sit down. The complainant said she waited for the crowd to clear before approaching the table again to get food. The complainant stated that when she went back, no one was around her. The complainant said someone brushed against her again and saw the suspect. The complainant stated that there was plenty of space to walk around her. The complainant stated the suspect rubbed his erect penis against her butt over her clothing. The complainant was asked how she knew it was the suspect's penis; she responded, "nothing else feels that way." The complainant stated after the incident, the suspect gave her an unwanted hug, grabbed her waist, and did not let her go. The complainant stated that the suspect did not say anything to her. The complainant stated that afterwards, she went to the restroom and sent a message to her friend, witness Jayda Leach, about what happened. The complainant talked to witness Mariah Crawford, who took her to speak with pastor Adria Green. The complainant stated immediately after Church; that she told her mother that she needed to talk to the youth pastor, witness Adria Green, also known as "Pastor A." The complainant then made the outcry to the youth pastor. The youth pastor contacted the complainant's mother and reported the incident.

On April 25, 2022, I/O R. Jones #10542 interviewed the complainant's mother and father, Votika and Marvin Mitchell, at Dallas Children's Advocacy Center. The interview was audio and video recorded.

The R/P stated the complainant came to her after Sunday service and asked the R/P if she could leave to speak with witness Adria Green. The R/P spoke with witness Green and asked her if it was alright for the complainant to have time with her. The R/P stated she received a text message later from witness Green telling the R/P she needed to speak with her; it was important. Witness Green called the R/P and told her about the complainant's outcry. The complainant stated the suspect rubbed his erect penis against the complainant's clothed buttocks.

The R/P stated she didn't personally know the suspect. The R/P said she knew of the suspect because of his position at the Church. The R/P stated they'd attended the Church for approximately a year.

On April 26, 2022, witness Adria Green was interviewed at Dallas Police Child Exploitation Unit. The interview was audio and video recorded. Witness Green is the youth pastor at Antioch Church. During the interview, the witness stated that one of her youth leaders, Mariah Crawford, reported that the complainant needed to speak with her. The complainant was inside witness Green's office. Witness Green said the complainant made the outcry to her. Afterward, Witness Green and the complainant reported the offense to the complainant's mother. Witness green also reported the offense to Human Resources and Executive Senior Pastor Chris Wesley and Executive Pastor DeWayne High.

The witness stated while speaking with the complainant, the complainant said the suspect made her feel uncomfortable. The witness stated other individuals had mentioned feeling uncomfortable by the suspect's actions. The witness stated the complainant told her the suspect hugged her too

told her to do what Pastor Green told her. The witness said she could see that something was wrong with the complainant.

On May 5, 2022, witness Brianna Terrell was interviewed at Dallas Police Child Exploitation Unit. The interview was audio and video recorded. Witness Terrell is currently employed as the Leadership Coordinator at Antioch Church. Witness Terrell has been employed for approximately two years. Witness Terrell stated that prior to her employment, she had been a member at Antioch Church for approximately 17 years. The witness said when she was first hired, she was assigned to work for Executive Pastor Dewayne High. The witness stated that shortly after being hired, her supervisors switched, and she worked under the suspect, Executive Pastor Andrew Wilburn. The witness stated while employed; the suspect began harassing her. The witness said that the suspect called her "Baby Mama." The witness stated that she felt uncomfortable around the suspect and that he would send her text messages. The witness said the suspect tried to kiss her and rub her feet on one occasion. The witness stated that she felt uncomfortable. The witness also described another incident when the suspect was behind her; the witness stated that her pants tag was showing outside her pants. The suspect pushed the tag back inside her pants with his finger touching the top of the witness's butt. The witness stated she filed a formal complaint sent through Human Resources and was seen by the board of trustees. The witness said that since her complaint, the suspect is still employed at Antioch Church. The witness stated that she no longer works under the supervision of the suspect.

On May 19, 2022, witness Joel Leach was interviewed at Dallas Police Child Exploitation Unit. The interview was audio and video recorded. Witness Joel Leach is the chairman of the Board of Trustees for Antioch Church. During the interview, the witness stated that the executive pastors are overseen by the board of trustees. The board holds financial responsibilities for the Church. The board oversees complaints and the budget for Antioch Church. The witness stated that he found out about the offense when Human Resources referred the incident to the board of trustees. The witness is also a 20-year member of Antioch Church. The witness stated that he had heard rumors throughout the Church about the suspect being "too friendly and touchy." The witness also stated that the suspect had a formal complaint filed against him by an employee regarding sexual harassment. The witness said the board sustained the allegations. The witness also stated that a Deacon reported that the suspect sent direct social media messages to his niece. The witness stated he did not know about any other formal complaints against the suspect.

During the interview, the witness denied knowing his daughter had reported feeling uncomfortable around the suspect. The witness also denied knowing the suspect sat his daughter, witness Jayda Leach in the suspect's lap.

On August 24, 2022, witness Alexis Perry was interviewed at Dallas Police Child Exploitation Unit. The interview was audio and video recorded. Witness Alexis Perry is a former employee and former member. The witness stated that she was a member of Antioch Church for approximately 30 years. The witness said that she was employed from March 2020 till June 2021. The witness stated while a member of Antioch Church; she was an active participant in the youth choir, youth usher, and youth bible study. The witness said she was employed as pastor Christopher Wesley's personal and business assistant. The witness stated her daily role was the youth group schedule and private scheduling for pastor Christopher Wesley. The witness said the plan was for

complainant. The suspect admitted to knowing the complainant. I/O R. Jones #10542 showed the suspect a photograph of the complainant. The suspect needed to end the interview due to a family situation and agreed to reschedule the interview.

On January 17, 2023, I/O R. Jones #19542 conducted a single photo lineup at Dallas Police Child Exploitation Unit with the complainant. The lineup was audio and video recorded. The complainant positively identified the suspect by a photograph that was shown by I/O Jones #10542. The complainant signed the picture and dated the photograph.
