PERMANENT VOLUNTARY SURRENDER
OF TEXAS EDUCATOR CERTIFICATE

This Permanent Voluntary Surrender is executed pursuant to the authority of the Administrative Procedure Act, TEX. GOV'T. CODE §2001.056, and 19 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §249.35(b), which authorize the informal disposition of contested cases. In a desire to conclude this matter without further delay and expense, the Board and Respondent agree to resolve this matter by this Permanent Voluntary Surrender.

The State Board for Educator Certification received a report that TREY SHONKWILER, herein referred to as Respondent, who holds Texas Educator Certificate Number [REDACTED] has engaged in conduct that violates the Texas Educators' Code of Ethics, including, but not limited to, soliciting or engaging in sexual conduct or a romantic relationship with a student or minor.

To avoid the uncertainty and expense of litigation in this matter, Respondent agrees to the entry of this Permanent Voluntary Surrender surrendering his Texas Educator Certificate.

Respondent further agrees to the entry of his name on the registry of persons not eligible for employment in public schools under Texas Education Code §22.092(a).

The Board is authorized, pursuant to 19 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §249.15(a)(4) to revoke or cancel, which includes accepting the surrender of a certificate without opportunity for reapplication for a set term or permanently.

Respondent, by his signature below, hereby voluntarily surrenders Texas Educator Certificate Number [REDACTED]. The surrender is permanent without opportunity for reapplication.

By signing this Permanent Voluntary Surrender, Respondent waives the right to a formal hearing, and any right to seek removal of or judicial review of this Permanent Voluntary Surrender.

Ms. Christensen:

The Texas Education Agency, acting on behalf of the State Board for Educator Certification has received notification that you have been convicted of Possession and Distribution of Visual Depictions of Sexual Activities by Minors and were sentenced to 188 months incarceration. Additionally, this agency has been informed that on or about December 7, 2020, you were committed to the custody of the United States Bureau of Prisons.


Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, section 53.021(b), a license holder's license shall be revoked, by operation of law, immediately upon the license holder's imprisonment following a felony conviction, felony community supervision revocation, revocation of parole, or revocation of mandatory supervision. Once a license holder is no longer incarcerated, he or she is eligible to reapply for the license, subject to all the requirements for obtaining such a license. Tex. Att'y Gen. Op. No. GA-0064 (2003). You are not eligible to reapply for a license within 5 years from the date of this revocation, 19 Texas Administrative Code 249.44 (b). If your period of incarceration extends past 5 years from the date of this revocation, you will be eligible to reapply for a license when released, subject to all requirements for obtaining such a license.

Accordingly, unless you are able to show cause within ten days of receipt of this notice why this revocation did not take effect, the official records of Texas educator certifications will be corrected to reflect your certificate was revoked by operation of law pursuant to section 53.021(b) of the Texas Occupations Code, effective as of the date of your imprisonment, December 7, 2020.

In addition, pursuant to Texas Education Code, Chapter 21, Section 21.058, as amended on June 20, 2003, this agency is required to revoke your Texas Educator Certificate immediately upon learning of your conviction of a felony offense under Title 5, Penal Code, or an offense on conviction with a requirement to register as a sex offender under Chapter 62, Code of Criminal Procedure. In either case, the age of the victim being under the age of 18. Accordingly, this letter will serve as notice that your Texas Educator Certificate Number [REDACTED] has also been revoked pursuant to Texas Education Code, Chapter 21, Section 21.058. Pursuant to the Texas Administrative Code, 19 TAC 249.44 (b), you are not eligible to reapply for a license within 5 years from the date of this revocation, subject to all requirements for obtaining such a license.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER


Came on for consideration on the **21st day of February 2020**, the above-styled matter.

The State Board for Educator Certification ("Board") finds that after proper and timely notice was given to Respondent in the above-numbered and styled case, Respondent failed to timely file an answer in response to Petitioner's Original Petition. Pursuant to 19 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 249.35(f)(1), the Petitioner filed a Request for Issuance of Default Judgment containing proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. Petitioner's request was properly served on all parties as part of the record in the case.

The Board, after review and due consideration of Petitioner's Request for Default, adopts the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the Request for Issuance of Default Judgment as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Board pursuant to 19 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 249.15 and TEX. EDUC. CODE § 21.031 and § 21.041(b)(7) that: Respondent **JULIO RAMIREZ'S** Texas Educator Certificates Numbered [REDACTED] and any other Texas educator credentials held by Respondent are hereby **PERMANENTLY REVOKED**.

2. The Commissioner is authorized, pursuant to TEXAS EDUCATION CODE §§22.092(c)(5) and 22.094 to add individuals who commit misconduct described in Tex. EDUC. CODE §22.093(c)(1)(A) and (B) to the registry of persons not eligible for employment in Texas public schools.

3. **TREVOR SWIFT** has committed misconduct described in TEX. EDUC. CODE §22.093(c)(1)(A) and/or (B) abused or otherwise committed an unlawful act with a student or minor and/or was involved in a romantic relationship with or solicited or engaged in sexual contact with a student or minor.

4. **TREVOR SWIFT** should be placed on the registry of persons not eligible for employment in public schools in accordance with TEXAS EDUCATION CODE §§22.092(c)(5) and 22.094.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

TREVOR SWIFT is hereby added to the registry of persons not eligible for employment in Texas public schools.
