

Defend Texas Liberty PAC Texas Statewide 2024 Likely Republican June Issue Poll

This survey was conducted from June 28 – June 30, 2023, through a series of interactive voice response calls and online surveys delivered via SMS messages. 764 survey respondents were randomly selected from a demographically proportionate sample of likely 2024 Texas Republican primary voters. Weighted demographics include age and gender. The survey has a ±3.546% margin of error with a confidence level of 95%.
