INITIAL NARRATIVE

On 1/3/2022 at approximately 0014 hours, I, Officer J. Duncan, was dispatched to a call from Stop It Solutions, which is a tip reporting service utilized by New Tech High School, located at 113 Samuel Blvd, Coppell, Dallas County, Texas. A representative of the service, identified as "Agent 3", advised a report was received from an anonymous New Tech High School student stating another student in 10th grade, [REDACTED] threatened to kill a teacher, Haley Arroyo. The information provided also stated New Tech High School contacts Rachel Freeman and Angela Brown were left voicemails regarding the incident. I contacted Stop It Solutions and requested the incident that was forwarded and was emailed Incident [REDACTED]. The email showed a screenshot of a conversation on an unknown social media outlet between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on 12/09/2021. "[REDACTED]" stated, "I HATE ARROYO I HATE ARROYO," to which "[REDACTED]" replied, "We know." "[REDACTED]" then stated, "im going yo fucking kill her." A search of the teacher's name for New Tech High School showed Haley Arroyo to be an Honors Chemistry Teacher. I was unable to locate any further information for [REDACTED]. I checked for "[REDACTED]" on social media platforms and received multiple matches, none of which I was able to determine to be the subject of interest. I attached the screenshot of the conversation to this report.

On 1-3-2022, Det. Benson was assigned this case.

On 1-3-2022, Det. Benson called a phone number listed for Arroyo, but the voicemail advised it was for Justin Arroyo (husband). Det. Benson tried the second phone number listed but it belonged to her mother. Det. Benson asked for Haley's phone number, but her mother advised she did not want to provide any of her daughter's information.

Det. Benson conducted a records check and located a phone number for Haley of [REDACTED]. Det. Benson called Haley and left her a voicemail message for her to call back.

Justin called back and confirmed that was the correct phone number for Haley. Det. Benson asked Justin to send her a message asking her to give me a call.

Det. Benson received a phone call from Haley. Haley was unaware of the social media post. Haley had not been contacted by Coppell ISD regarding the anonymous tip. Det. Benson advised Haley of the social media post. Det. Benson asked Haley if she had a [REDACTED] in class and she advised yes, but he goes by "[REDACTED]". Det. Benson asked if she had any issues with him previously. Haley advised she had not. Haley advised he was engaged and trying in her class at the beginning of the semester, but had gradually not been performing as well. Haley advised she had heard a rumor that if [REDACTED] did not keep his grades up, that he may be sent to a boarding school. Haley did not have any more information and Det. Benson advised he would call back later to touch base.

Det. Benson contacted School Resource Officer (SRO) Joe Boyd and asked for help with gathering contact information for [REDACTED]. SRO Boyd met Det. Benson and Sgt. Louderback at New Tech High School. Det. Benson learned Campbell's home address was [REDACTED] along with other identifying information. Det. Benson asked SRO Boyd if he had any dealings with [REDACTED] and he advised he had not.

Det. Benson and Sgt. Louderback went to [REDACTED] and met with John Campbell (Father), Angela Campbell (Mother), and [REDACTED] aka [REDACTED]. From here forward the son will be referred to as [REDACTED]. Det. Benson showed John and Angela the social media post with the user name. John advised that was his son, [REDACTED]'s user name. Det. Benson advised the parents they would like to speak with [REDACTED] to understand the context of the post that was posted on December 9, 2021. John and Angela invited Det. Benson and Sgt. Louderback in to speak with them and [REDACTED]. John went and got [REDACTED]. Everyone sat around the dining room table.

[REDACTED] admitted he posted those comments out of frustration, but did not ever intend to hurt anyone. [REDACTED] advised the post was actually on a social media app called Discord, under a channel by that was setup for New Tech school students to specifically post their frustrations. [REDACTED] admitted it was a poor word choice and he should have never posted it. [REDACTED] was apologetic and very respectful. John and Angela were very cooperative and respectful. Det. Benson and Sgt. Louderback provided [REDACTED] with some educational information related to how social media content has the potential to get students into trouble both criminally and with a school district. [REDACTED] advised he understood. John and Angela advised they had withdrawn [REDACTED] from New Tech High School on the last day before the winter break and he would be attending a different high school in the spring. John, Angela, and [REDACTED] were advised at this time, this incident would be documented as an information report and would not be criminal in nature.

Det. Benson called Haley back and provided her with an update. Det. Benson explained he had spoken with [REDACTED] and his family regarding the matter. Det. Benson explained to Haley that the incident did not arise to a criminal level, but would be documented within the information report.

This case is unfounded.
