

Defend Texas Liberty PAC Texas Statewide 2024 Likely Republican July Issue Poll

This survey was conducted from July 30– July 31, 2023, through a series of online surveys delivered via SMS messages. 606 survey respondents were randomly selected from a demographically proportionate sample of likely 2024 Texas Republican primary voters. Weighted demographics include age and gender. The survey has a ±3.981% margin of error with a confidence level of 95%.
