Communication sent 5:52 p.m. March 5: Pike Middle School families,

Tuesday evening, the Tarrant County Sheriff's Department notified us of the arrest of David Goggins, a current Pike Middle School teacher. Arrest and booking details state Mr. Goggins was charged with aggravated sexual assault of a child. The conduct allegedly occurred before he was employed in Northwest ISD, and Northwest ISD had no knowledge of the allegations at the time he was hired or while he was actively teaching in the district.

According to information shared with us, the matter does not involve a current or former Northwest ISD student, and police are not seeking additional victims. The allegations relate to an incident at a prior school district that were reported by a student of that district this school year. Once made aware of the report, Northwest ISD immediately placed Mr. Goggins on administrative leave and denied him access to our school and any other district schools.

Because of the ongoing nature of the police investigation and legal proceedings, we cannot provide further details at this time. Please know we take seriously any allegations of improper conduct between an employee and student, and we will take immediate action for the safety of students when such allegations are reported.
