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UPDATE: Round Rock ISD Superintendent who has a Permanent Restraining Order Failed to Comply with Texas Law during Hiring of Police Chief & Assistant Chief.

The School Board is once again failing to hold the Superintendent accountable for his failure to ensure the SAFETY of children. The Superintendent withheld the information contained in a Texas Commission of Law Enforcement (TCOLE) letter that Azaiez had not properly followed Texas law during the hiring of both Chief Weiner and Assistant Chief White.

Due to a concern emailed to the entire board in early January 2023 I requested an agenda item to discuss TCOLE licensing of the Chief and Assistant. Board President Amber Feller Landrum continually denied and ignored the request. On April 21, 2023, Azaiez finally responded to a request by Trustee Weston that both the Chief and Assistant Chief had received their TCOLE license. During these months, the children were failed by the RRISD Board majority (Amy Weir, Amber Feller Landrum, Tiffanie Harrison, Alicia Markum and Chuy Zarate) to provide proper oversight of the ISD Police Department. Currently both the Chief and Assistant Chief have been placed on administrative leave. Could the issues surrounding Round Rock ISD be the Superintendent with a Permanent Restraining Order? Currently the majority of the Board is sticking by their man and without any proof blindly believing him.

Now I recently discovered from a Facebook post by [Jeremy W Story](#), who was removed from a Round Rock ISD public meeting and later arrested, that in May of 2023 TCOLE started an investigation on the hiring of both the ISD Police Chief and Assistant Chief. While it is reasonable to believe that the district had awareness of the TCOLE investigation, the Superintendent never informed the full board. The Superintendent received the following letter on December 20, 2023, almost a full year after my concern was raised, but Azaiez still failed to share this alarming letter with the full board. Although I officially asked for the following, the Superintendent never produced the December letter from TCOLE on the investigation which in my view is another failure to comply with law (TEC 11.1512).

Documentation regarding "Any and all investigations in the last 18 months regarding any and all police department staff (including the chief and/or assistant chief) on RRISD PD including any and all lighthouse reports that would have initiated an investigation." and staffing. (BR 2024-012)

and

"Documentation that the district has regarding the investigation into the Chief and/or Assistant police Chief." (BR 2024-015)

S.O.S!!!

Texas Education Agency WHERE ARE YOU? Texas Education Agency here is another example of Round Rock ISD Board and Superintendent failing to properly follow law through multiple points of failure: 1) Unlawful hiring practices; 2) Board President not following agenda policy; and 3) Superintendent not turning over investigation when Trustee legally requested it.
