TEA Standard 1.10	The educator shall be of good moral character and be worthy to instruct or supervise the youth of this state.
TEA Standard 3.2	The educator shall not intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly treat a student or minor in a manner that adversely affects or endangers the learning, physical health, mental health, or safety of the student or minor.

Id. As such, neither student outbursts nor locking classroom doors—especially in light of requirements of all teachers locking their classroom doors pursuant to school security procedures—would indicate anything remotely close to sexual misconduct.

Any alleged knowledge of Crenshaw's actual sexual contact was only realized after-the-fact.
