**SUBJECT: CONSIDERATION TO ACCEPT FISCAL YEAR 2025 STATE CRIMINAL AND JUSTICE PLANNING GRANT AWARD FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR THE HUMAN TRAFFICKING UNIT IN THE TARRANT COUNTY CRIMINAL DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE**

**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider accepting FY 2025 State Criminal and Justice Planning Grant Award from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, for the Human Trafficking Unit in the Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's (CDA) Office.

**BACKGROUND**

Human trafficking is increasing at an alarming rate across Texas. The Human Trafficking Unit is needed to fully seek justice on behalf of survivors and maximize the newly implemented county-coordinated trauma-based team approach.

On January 23, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142469, approved the submission of the FY 2025 State Criminal Justice Planning Funds grant application to seek grant funding in the amount of \$423,919.45, to continue to partially fund one (1) Attorney, one (1) Investigator and one (1) Legal Secretary position in the Human Trafficking Unit in the CDA's Office.

Acceptance of this grant award, in the amount of \$423,919.45, will allow the CDA's Office to continue to fund the Human Trafficking Unit.

The grant term is 12 months, starting October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025.

The Budget and Risk Management Office has reviewed the statement of grant award. The grant award has been approved as to form by the Criminal District Attorney's Office.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The grant award for Grant G0097-2025 is \$423,919.45. Matching funds are not required. Indirect costs were not added to the program budget. Operating Subsidy of \$34,373.00 is available in account 10020-2025 General Fund/ 4510300000 Criminal DA Felony/ 592021 Operating Sub-Grants.
