SUBJECT: RECENT WPA INTELLIGENCE POLL SHOWS MAJORITY SUPPORT FOR ESTABLISHING AN EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNT PROGRAM IN TEXAS

DATE: FEBRUARY 19, 2025

A new poll by WPA Intelligence in Texas, conducted on behalf of Club for Growth February 16-18, 2025, shows that a majority of Texas voters support passage of an Education Savings Account program to give parents a choice in their children's educations, including strong support from both Republican and Independent voters.

A majority of Texas voters support establishing an Education Savings Account program.

- A majority (56%) of voters say they support this program after hearing a brief description of the bill that passed the State Senate.
- Only 36% of voters oppose the change.
- Another 8% are unsure.

Education Savings Account Program

Support for the program is strong among both Republicans and Independent voters.

- Nearly seven-in-ten (68%) of Republican voters support the program with just 23% in opposition.
- A majority (52%) of Independent voters supports the program with just 40% opposed.

Methodology

WPAi conducted a poll of n = 825 registered voters in Texas. Data was collected February 16-18, 2025, using a combination of live calls to cellphones (44%), SMS-to-web surveys to cell phones (33%), and live calls to landline phones (23%). The sample was selected from the Texas voter file and was stratified by geography, age, gender, ethnicity, and educational attainment. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 3.4\%$ at the 95% confidence level.
