**ORDER DENYING REQUEST  
FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND SETTING  
TEMPORARY INJUNCTION HEARING**

On the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December 2025, came on to be considered *County Commissioner Jason Corley's Original Petition*, containing an application for the issuance of an *ex parte* temporary restraining order restraining the Defendant, Mark Meurer, from acting as the duly authorized County Commissioner of Precinct 2, Lubbock County, Texas. The Court finds that exigent circumstances do not exist for the issuance of a temporary restraining order, without notice and hearing. It is, therefore, ORDERED that Jason Corley's request for an *ex parte* temporary restraining order is DENIED.

The Court further finds that Corley's request for an expeditious hearing on his application for temporary injunction is warranted and should be granted. It is,

therefore, ORDERED that Jason Corley's application for temporary injunction is set for hearing on December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. in the courtroom of the 237<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Lubbock County Courthouse, located at 904 Broadway Street, Lubbock, Texas 79401. The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether the Court should temporarily enjoin the Defendant, Mark Meurer, from acting as the duly authorized County Commissioner of Precinct 2, Lubbock County, Texas, pending final disposition of this cause.
