This letter ("Document Request") shall serve as a public information request under the Texas Public Information Act, Tex. Gov't Code §552.001 et seq., for copies of records in their *original (electronic/paper) format*. We agree to mandatory redactions. We do not agree to discretionary exceptions.

REQUESTED RECORDS:

January 1, 2025 to the date a search is conducted.

- A list of all open records requests (also known as public information requests) submitted to Georgetown, Texas, and all its departments except for the city's police department. We want the name and email of the requester, the information requested, and the date the request was received. We seek no list of open records requests sent to the police department. .

We request a waiver of all fees as we are a 501(c)3 non-profit news media organization, and the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of City of Georgetown. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes.

The Texas Public Information Act requires that you "promptly produce" the requested records unless, within 10 days, you have sought an Attorney General's Opinion. If you expect a significant delay in responding to this request, please contact me with information about when I might expect copies or the ability to inspect the requested records.

If you deny any or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law.
