**Public Statement on Compliance Review of Anxiety Solutions of America**

United Way of Hood County has conducted a compliance review of Anxiety Solutions of America, a nonprofit organization based in Hood County, Texas. The purpose of this review was to confirm that appropriate legal, governance, and financial practices are in place as the organization continues its development.

**Documentation reviewed included:**

- IRS determination letter confirming federal tax-exempt status
- Texas Comptroller and Secretary of State filings
- Board bylaws and meeting minutes with signature approvals
- Written financial policies and procedures
- Approved annual operating budget
- Documentation of property ownership and program operations

**Findings:**

Based on the materials reviewed, United Way of Hood County found no compliance deficiencies. The organization has established appropriate governance structures, maintains accurate board minutes, has adopted and follows written financial policies and procedures, and has approved an annual operating budget. In addition, the Executive Director serves on a volunteer basis without compensation and does not have direct access to organizational banking funds, further strengthening internal controls.

**Conclusion:**

At this time, United Way of Hood County recognizes Anxiety Solutions of America as being in good standing with respect to nonprofit governance, compliance, and best practices. We commend the organization for its commitment to serving veterans and their families with transparency and integrity, and we look forward to the continued positive impact of its work in our community.
