INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury Charges:

Count One
Enticement of a Minor
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2422(b))

From on or about a date unknown to the grand jury, to on or about March 12, 2026, the Lubbock Division of the Northern District of Texas, and elsewhere, **Joseph Macaulay Gonzalez**, defendant, did knowingly use a facility and means of interstate and foreign commerce, to persuade, induce, entice, and coerce, and attempt to persuade, induce, entice, and coerce, "Jane Doe 2," an individual who had not attained the age of 18 years, to engage in sexual activity for which any person can be charged with a criminal offense.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2422(b).
