**VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT TO RESIGN FROM  
JUDICIAL OFFICE IN LIEU OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

This Agreement is being entered into by the undersigned parties pursuant to Section 33.032(h) of the Texas Government Code.

**WHEREAS** at all times relevant hereto, the Honorable Rosie Speedlin-Gonzalez was Judge of the County Court at Law No. 13, in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 7, 2025, a complaint was filed with the Commission alleging Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez exhibited unprofessional demeanor, threatened a defense attorney with contempt, and ordered the bailiff to handcuff the defense attorney and place her in the jury box; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about January 29, 2026, a duly constituted Grand Jury of the 379<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court of Bexar County, Texas handed up an Indictment against Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez charging her with one count of Unlawful Restraint: Peace Officer/Judge, a Class A Misdemeanor, and one count of Official Oppression, a Class A Misdemeanor in Cause No. 2026CR001028; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 5, 2026, the State Commission on Judicial Conduct suspended Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez, without pay, based on the above-referenced Indictment; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 31, 2025, a complaint was filed with the Commission alleging Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez exhibited unprofessional demeanor toward a criminal defendant and that she failed to timely proceed on a motion to modify bond conditions and two writs of habeas corpus; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 2, 2026, a complaint was filed with the Commission alleging Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez abused her judicial authority by issuing a "no contact" order via email prohibiting staff of Bexar County's Reflejo Court and County Court at Law No. 13 from communicating with former specialty court team members and employees of the court; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 5, 2026, a complaint was filed with the Commission, alleging Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez abused her judicial authority by issuing a “no contact” order via email prohibiting staff of Bexar County’s Reflejo Court and County Court at Law No. 13 from communicating with former specialty court team members and employees of the court; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2026, a complaint was filed with the Commission alleging Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez abused her judicial authority by issuing a “no contact” order via email prohibiting staff of Bexar County’s Reflejo Court and County Court at Law No. 13 from communicating with former specialty court team members and employees of the court; and

**WHEREAS** no Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law have been entered by the Commission in connection with the above-referenced matters; and

**WHEREAS** the parties agree that the allegations of judicial misconduct, if found to be true, could result in further disciplinary action against Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez; and

**WHEREAS** the parties to this Agreement are desirous of resolving these matters without the time and expense of further disciplinary proceedings.

**IT IS THEREFORE AGREED** that Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez, upon the signing of this Agreement, has officially and formally resigned her judicial duties, and is entering into this Agreement to resolve the above-referenced complaints in lieu of disciplinary action by the Commission, pursuant to Section 33.032(h) of the Texas Government Code. The Commission agrees that it shall pursue no further disciplinary proceedings against Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez in connection with the above-referenced matters.

**IT IS FURTHER AGREED** that, upon the Commission’s approval of this Agreement, Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez shall be forever disqualified from judicial service in the State of Texas, including: (a) sitting or serving as a judge, (b) standing for election or appointment to a judicial office, and/or (c) performing or exercising any judicial duties or functions of a judicial officer, including the performance of wedding ceremonies. This agreement does not prohibit Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez from the performance of wedding ceremonies under Section 2.202(a)(3) of the Texas Family Code, provided she does not wear a robe or refer in anyway to a judicial function or authority in the performance of a ceremony.

**IT IS FURTHER AGREED** that any violation of this Agreement by Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez would constitute willful or persistent conduct that is clearly inconsistent with the proper performance of her duties or casts public discredit upon the judiciary or administration of justice in violation of Art. V, Sec. 1-a(6)A of the Texas Constitution, and Section 33.001(b) of the Texas Government Code.


**IT IS FURTHER AGREED** that the Commission may enforce this Agreement through any legal process necessary, including injunctive relief; that Travis County, Texas, shall be the proper venue for any dispute between the parties or proceeding relating to this Agreement; and that Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez, individually, shall bear the expense, cost, and any reasonable and necessary attorneys’ fees in the event any dispute arising under this Agreement is decided against her by any court or tribunal.




**IT IS FURTHER AGREED** that Judge Speedlin-Gonzalez, by her execution of this voluntary agreement, does not admit guilt, fault or liability regarding the matters contained in CJC Nos. 25-1029, 26-0279, 26-0657, 26-0667 and 26-0817 referenced above.

**AGREED TO AND ACCEPTED** upon its execution by the parties.

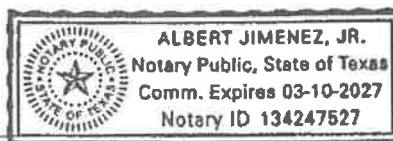
