ORDER APPOINTING ATTORNEY PRO TEM

WHEREAS the Relators filed this suit against the Prosper ISD Board Members and pursuant to Chapter 87 of the Texas Local Government Code this Court must appoint a prosecutor, I hereby appoint the Honorable Erleigh Wiley, District Attorney of Kaufman County, Texas, as the Attorney Pro Tem for the prosecution of the above numbered case.;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Erleigh Wiley, who is a District Attorney within the jurisdiction of the First Administrative Judicial Region, is appointed to perform the duties of Attorney Pro Tem for the investigation, prosecution, trial, appeals, habeas, and post-trial matters, if any, of this matter, regardless of the cause numbers or courts assigned to this matter. The above-named attorney for the State is appointed to serve as District Attorney Pro Tem in this matter and may assign this matter to any Assistant District Attorney of her County to prosecute this cause.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment is effective upon the execution of this order. If any legal objection exists wherein the attorney pro tem appointed herein is unable to legally fulfill her duty under Chapter 87 of the Local Government Code, the appointed attorney pro tem **shall** file a written motion with the appointing Court citing the specific legal objections.

The Court acknowledges the attorney appointed herein must take and execute an Oath of Office as required by law.

The Clerk of this Court is **ORDERED** to file a copy of this order with the papers in this cause. Further, the clerk is **ORDERED** to forward a copy of this order to the parties and the attorney pro tem appointed herein.
