Allowing a sitting state representative to make unsubstantiated allegations of illegal activity that she cannot substantiate sets a horrible precedent.

Enough time has gone by that one would think she would have produced evidence of her salacious allegations. Despite using her influence to prompt various state agencies to “investigate” our District and Foundation, she has not presented one shred of evidence to substantiate her allegations.

She has not provided evidence because there is none. The allegations were false, defamatory, and irresponsible. Such conduct falls far below the standard of behavior the public should expect from an elected official. Actions like these undoubtedly contributed to her facing opposition in the last election.

The only thing our Foundation is guilty of is success. Because of its accomplishments, our taxpayers and students will benefit generations to come. Through the vision and leadership of our Board of Trustees in establishing the Foundation, our school district has secured more than \$100 million that otherwise would not have been available to support our students and community.

Those resources are especially important considering that, since the inception of the Robin Hood recapture system, our district has sent more than \$300 million in local tax dollars back to the state for redistribution.

Our community's support speaks for itself. We have earned the highest accountability ratings from the state, have not raised the tax rate in more than 20 years, and have provided employee raises of 4% to 5% annually throughout that period.

We will continue to run one of the finest school districts in the State of Texas. We will also continue to vigorously defend the reputation of our District and Foundation, including pursuing all available legal remedies against anyone who makes false and defamatory statements about them — especially those entrusted with public office.
