Hi Robert,

The document you provided did not originate from Oncor and we are unable to confirm its authenticity or content. For information on parks and wildlife regions, please contact the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) or review the Environmental Assessments (EA) included within each CCN application. Oncor's route development process incorporates feedback from public stakeholders such as TPWD and follows the Public Utility Regulatory Act and the Public Utility Commission of Texas' Substantive Rules, including how they pertain to habitable structures, parks and recreational areas and other features. The EAs within each application list, quantify, and describe the spatial relationships of these and other features as required.

It is important to note that while habitable structures, parks and recreational areas and other features must be *considered* during the routing process, state requirements do not mandate that new transmission lines be *routed* specific distances from these features, but that the specific distances be used to outline project notice requirements.
